BASIC REQUIREMENTS FOR PAPERS:

Paper size — A4; ***margins***: — 2 cm; *the main text is Microsoft Word; font — Times New Roman, 14 pt; paragraph — 1.25 cm, width alignment; line spacing — 1.5; pages are not numbered; transposition of words is not allowed.*

The author's surname should be indicated in the letter's subject.

The materials must be designed according to the requirements.

Participation in the conference and a certificate indicating 8 hours (0.4 ECTS credits) are free.

Abstract in the language of the synopsis (without the word abstract, italics). 3 to 5 lines are recommended.

Keywords : (No paragraph indentation, at least five words, italics).

The main text should have the necessary elements: problem statement and its connection with actual theoretical or practical tasks, formulation of goals, links to current research and publications, presentation of the primary research material, and conclusions.

The bibliographic description is drawn up by the established requirements of DSTU 8302:2015 Information and documentation. Bibliographic reference. General provisions and rules of compilation.

Figures and tables are printed using the built-in Microsoft Word editor. The figure's name is printed in bold type and placed below the figure in the center. All drawings must be grouped as a single object—example of design: **Figure 1 – Sources of deficit financing**. The word "Table" is indicated once on the left above the first part of the table (with a paragraph indent); over other parts, write "Continuation of the table" with the table number.

Table 1 – Classification of financial resources.

The font size of the table text is 2 points smaller than the main font. Formulas are executed using the formula editor (internal formula editor in Microsoft Word for Windows).

References in the text to sources should be indicated in square brackets [source number, page], for example: [1, p. 13].
